

Infants & Children Ibuprofen Dosing

(Advil®, Motrin®, generic Ibuprofen)

DOSE: Every 6-8 hours as needed. DO NOT GIVE MORE THAN 4 DOSES IN 24 HOURS.		
mg = milligram mL = milliliter tsp = teaspoon

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

- Infants 0-3 months with fever of 100.4 or higher should see a doctor before treating with Ibuprofen or **TYLENOL®** due to risk of serious bacterial illness in this age group.
- Read and follow the label on all products.
- Take every 6-8 hours as needed. Do NOT exceed more than 4 doses in 24 hours.
- Do NOT administer longer than 10 days, unless directed by a doctor.
- Ask a doctor or pharmacist before use if the child is taking any other drug containing an NSAID* (prescription or non-prescription).
 - **MOTRIN®** contains ibuprofen.
- Use only the dosing device that comes with the specific product.
- **Keep all medicines out of reach of children.**

(TYLENOL® & generic Acetaminophen)

DOSE: Every 4 hours as needed. DO NOT GIVE MORE THAN 5 DOSES IN 24 HOURS.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PROPER USE

- Infants 0-3 months with fever of 100.4 or higher should see a doctor before treating with Ibuprofen or TYLENOL® due to risk of serious bacterial illness in this age group.
- Read and follow the label on all products.
- Take every 4 hours as needed. Do NOT exceed more than 5 doses in 24 hours.
- Do NOT use with any other product containing acetaminophen.
- Use only the dosing device that comes with the specific product.
- **All Infants' TYLENOL® and Children's TYLENOL® Oral Suspension products have the same acetaminophen concentration (160 mg/5mL).**
- **Keep all medicines out of reach of children.**

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
